Counsel for plaintiffs and counsel for defendants informed the Court that they had no objection to the interventions of George F. Dupuis, Sr. and E. M. Christensen and John Montesano. It is ordered by the Court that subpoenas be issued to compel the attendance of the members of the School Board who are not present. Oral testimony adduced and documentary evidence filed on behalf of the Lafayette Parish School Board until 3:55 P.M., and closed. For reasons and findings of fact orally assigned, IT IS ORDERED that the intervention of George F. Dupuis, Sr., be dismissed at his cost; that the intervention of John Montesano and E. M. Christensen be dismissed as their costs; and that the plan submitted to the Court by the Lafayette Parish School Board, approved by them on July 21, 1971, identified in this record as D-1 and D-2, with its accompanying addenda, be and the same is hereby APPROVED and adopted as the plan of operation of the Lafayette Parish School system for the year 1971-1972, reserving to the Board the right to continue to seek better and more effective means of bringing about an end to the dual school system formerly existing in this parish.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the attorney representing the School Board prepare a decree in keeping herewith, and that said decree embody in it the provisions described by the Court--See Reporter's Notes.)
