ORDER

On November 2, 2017, the court granted plaintiff's request for injunctive relief. The court adopted the State's proposed plan which included new parole procedures for juvenile offenders sentenced to life imprisonment without parole, and directed defendant to implement the plan within 90 days. Defendant subsequently appealed to the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit, and the appeal was voluntarily dismissed on March 22, 2018. (See (DE 101, 114)). The matter now comes before the court on the parties' consent motion for the award of costs, attorneys' fees, and related expenses (DE 117). The court GRANTS the parties' consent motion (DE 117), and awards costs in the amount of \$62,000.00 to plaintiff's attorneys.
