JUDGMENT

Judgment is hereby entered in accordance with the following:

1. A Memorandum and Order dated December 13, 2012, approving a Consent Decree, dated June 28, 2012, and filed with the court on December 13, 2012, replacing all prior orders and consent decrees in the case and resolving all equitable relief claims.
2. A Memorandum and Order dated November 30, 2015, as amended by Order dated January 29, 2016, approving the parties' Settlement Agreement resolving all monetary damage claims; and
3. A Memorandum and Order dated August 23, 2016, specifying the disposition of collected and uncollected fine funds. Pursuant to this Memorandum and Order, the collected fine funds that remain in the court's control after all previously identified expenses have been satisfied shall be paid to the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico. The Commonwealth will hold those monies, and the \$20 million now in a guaranty account, in a segregated account, and shall use those funds within the next three years for new expenditures that benefit inmates in Puerto Rico's correctional system. The Commonwealth's obligation to pay the remaining uncollected fines is cancelled.
