AND NOW, this 31st day of May 2018, upon considering the Defendants' Motion for partial summary judgment on the remaining ADEA disparate treatment claims (Count IV) (ECF Doc. No. 1374), Plaintiffs' Opposition (ECF Doc. No. 1399), continuing to remind counsel we are not addressing the individualized facts as more fully detailed in denying this same request in our January 29, 2018 Order (ECF Doc. No. 1273) and Defendants have not offered good cause as to why the passage of four months should change our trial plan set in our Orders and conferences, including our May 2, 2016 (ECF Doc. No. 852) and June 16, 2017 (ECF Doc. No. 1156) Orders, it is **ORDERED** the Defendants' renewed Motion for partial summary judgment (ECF Doc. No. 1374) is **DENIED without prejudice** to be renewed when the trial court addresses the remaining individual claims brought by persons from outside this Commonwealth against an Illinois citizen.
