ORDER

Upon review of the parties' briefs on the Renewed Motion for a Preliminary Injunction filed by Petitioners Angel Guzman Cedillo and William Kemcha, ECF No. 79, the Court finds that the following information is relevant and material to the resolution of the Motion. Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. Respondents shall PRODUCE for *in camera* review the following information by **Tuesday, May 5, 2020:**

- a. All medical records covering the period from March 1, 2020 to the date of this Order for all inmates or detainees at Worcester County Detention Center (“WCDC”) who, during any part of this time period, stayed overnight in the medical housing area, an isolation cell, or any location other than their assigned cells, for any medical reason.
 - b. An affidavit from the Medical Director of WCDC or the Warden of WCDC affirming under penalty of perjury that the submitted records represent all records satisfying these criteria.
2. The required medical records shall be FILED under seal, *ex parte*, and in an unredacted form. Each inmate’s or detainee’s set of medical records covering the relevant time period shall be filed as a separate exhibit.
