**STIPULATED ORDER GRANTING
DEFENDANT BERNALILLO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS'
UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR FINDING OF INITIAL COMPLIANCE
AND TO SET SELF-MONITORING PERIOD REGARDING DOMAIN #3**

THIS MATTER, came before the Court on Defendant Bernalillo County's Unopposed Motion for Finding of Initial Substantial Compliance and to Set Self-Monitoring Period Regarding Domain #3. The Court having reviewed the pleading, considered that all parties concur in the relief requested, and being otherwise fully advised on the premises, finds the Motion is well-taken and will be **GRANTED**.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Defendant Bernalillo County's Unopposed Motion for Finding of Initial Substantial Compliance and to Set Self-Monitoring Period Regarding Domain #3 is GRANTED.

2. Defendants achieved initial substantial compliance with Domain #3 as of July 1, 2019;
and
3. The self-monitoring period for Domain #3 will conclude on August 19, 2021, eighteen calendar months from the entry of this Order.
