Dear Hon. Judge Baum;

I was placed in the Wayne County Jail on or about July 7, 1974 on a Assault and Battery Charge and was found guilty on Sept. 18, 1974 in the Hon. Judge Gillis Court Room. However, in the 70 or so days awaiting trial in the county jail, I was communally assaulted, denied medical treatment and special Diet and all Social Services. The store Vendor personal also repeatedly took my money and goods. I tried to file a formal complaint when I went to court before Judge Gillis one day and he simply as the prosecutor to see what I had to say. The prosecutor took me into the "Jury Room" and before I could explain what happen, He jumped up from his chair and stated "I think you are Bull Sh----- me" and that was the end of my attempt to file a complaint before the officials regarding the completely criminal conduct on the parts of the Wayne County officials.

I therefore would like to petition this Panel to issue a writ of Habeas Corpus to bring me forth to submit my complaint. The Docket No. was: 78105-1-1-1 Judge Gillis Court Room.
