Defendants are PERMANENTLY ENJOINED from enforcing the Transport Requirement, Fla. Stat. § 908.104(4), because this statutory provision is preempted by federal immigration law and is therefore unconstitutional. Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 58, the Court will enter final judgment by separate order. The Clerk of Court is directed to CLOSE this case. Closing Case.
