ORDER

Plaintiffs having moved this Court for a preliminary injunction affording detainees contact visits at the Bronx House of Detention, and the Court by its memorandum of May 6, 1975 having granted plaintiffs' motion and having ordered defendants to submit a plan for providing such contact visits, and the Court having considered defendants' plan and the alternative proposals submitted by plaintiffs, and having inspected the parties' proposed contact visitation sites at the Bronx House of Detention on July 6, 1976, and having issued a memorandum decision dated July 13, 1976 specifying the relief to be afforded plaintiffs, it is hereby

ORDERED, that defendants commence a temporary contact visitation program at the Bronx House of Detention no later than September 15, 1976, which will afford each member of the plaintiff class at least one one-hour contact visit each week; and it is further,

ORDERED, that defendants submit a plan as soon as practicable for the creation of a permanent facility which will insure that every visit at the Bronx House of Detention will be a contact visit as soon as possible and, in any event, no later than May 15, 1977; and it is further

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ORDERED, that defendants provide contact visits on all
visiting occasions at the Bronx House of Detention as soon as
such permanent facility is completed.
