SECOND ORDER MODIFYING
JUDGMENT ORDER OF JULY 1, 1969

This matter coming on to be heard on the joint motion of the parties requesting certain modifications in this Court's judgment order of July 1, 1969, which motion is made pursuant to the provisions of Article X of said judgment order whereby this Court has retained jurisdiction of this matter for all purposes including the purposes particularly enumerated therein, and

The Court having conferred with counsel for the parties and having determined that the provisions of this modifying order are based upon relevant information with respect to the subject matter, counsel having discussed the same with the Court prior to the entry of said judgment order, and that said provisions are appropriate and are consistent with and in furtherance of the reasons for the issuance of said judgment order.

It is hereby ordered:

- I. Article III, subsection A of the judgment order, providing that certain Dwelling Units may be made available for occupancy without restriction imposed by said order, is hereby modified by the addition of the following as paragraph (3) thereof:

"(3) Leased Dwelling Units as follows:

- (a) Not more than 101 Leased Dwelling Units within the buildings located at Cottage Grove Avenue between 60th and 63rd Streets in the City of Chicago, Illinois, sometimes described as the 'TWO-KMF Development Association Development,' and not more than 151 additional Leased Dwelling Units within the Woodlawn area of the City of Chicago in other so-called "221(d)(3) projects" under development within such area on July 1, 1969.
- (b) 30 Leased Dwelling Units within a building or buildings to be located at 47th Street between Woodlawn and Ellis Avenues in the City of Chicago, Illinois, sometimes described as the 'Lake Village Development (Urban Associates) Project.'
- (c) 6 Leased Dwelling Units within the building located at 6442-44 South Maryland Avenue in the City of Chicago, Illinois.
- (d) 65 Leased Dwelling Units within the buildings located at the street addresses in the City of Chicago listed on Exhibit C attached hereto, to be leased pursuant to the arrangement sometimes described as the "Chicago Plan (CHA, CDA, FHA) Agreement," (such 65 Leased Dwelling Units being in addition to 97 apartments leased prior to July 1, 1969 pursuant to such arrangement).
- (e) That number (but not more than 250) of Leased Dwelling Units needed to meet the needs of large families within buildings located in the area bounded by Lawndale Avenue on the west, Albany Avenue on the east, the first alley north of Douglas Boulevard on the north, and the first alley south of Douglas Boulevard on the south in the City of Chicago, to be leased pursuant to the arrangement sometimes described as the 'Douglas-Lawndale (Joint HUD-DUR) Urban Renewal Project.'

II. Except as and to the extent otherwise expressly provided in this modifying order, this Court's judgment order of July 1,

1969 as heretofore modified remains in full force and effect.
