MOTION FOR STAY OF MANDATE
PENDING PETITION FOR CERTIORARI

Defendants-appellants (hereinafter collectively called "CHA"), by their attorneys, respectfully move this court to stay the issuance of its mandate to the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division, until March 13, 1971, so that CHA may file with the Supreme Court of the United States a petition for writ of certiorari. In support of said motion, CHA states as follows:

1. On December 16, 1970 this court entered judgment affirming the order appealed from and ordering the cause remanded

to the district court for further proceedings; on December 30, 1970, CHA filed a timely petition for rehearing.

2. This Court denied CHA's petition for rehearing on Thursday, February 18, 1971. Notice of this fact to CHA's attorneys was receipt of the order denying said petition on Monday, February 22, 1971. Unless otherwise ordered, the mandate of this Court will issue on February 25, 1971.

3. CHA is presently preparing a petition to the United States Supreme Court for a writ of certiorari, and CHA will file said petition with the clerk of the Supreme Court of the United States on or before the close of business on March 8, 1971, so that the clerk of this Court should receive from the clerk of the Supreme Court of the United States a notice of the filing of said petition no later than March 13, 1971 (allowing five days for said notice to issue and be delivered to the clerk of this Court).

For the foregoing reasons, CHA respectfully requests that this Court stay the issuance of its mandate until March 13, 1971.
