3. Paragraph three of the Supplemental Complaint does not refer to this defendant, and this defendant makes no response thereto.
4. Admits the allegations contained in paragraph four of the Supplemental Complaint.
5. Admits the allegations contained in paragraph five of the Supplemental Complaint.

6. Admits the allegation contained in paragraph six of the Supplemental Complaint.

7. Paragraph seven of the Supplemental Complaint does not refer to this defendant, and this defendant makes no response thereto.

8. Admits the allegation contained in paragraph eight of the Supplemental Complaint.

9. Admits the allegations contained in the first sentence of paragraph nine of the Supplemental Complaint. Further answering, the defendant is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of the allegation contained in the second sentence of paragraph nine of the Supplemental Complaint.

10. Paragraph ten of the Supplemental Complaint does not refer to this defendant, and this defendant makes no response thereto.

11. Paragraph eleven of the Supplemental Complaint does not refer to this defendant, and this defendant makes no response thereto.

12. Admits the allegations contained in the first sentence of paragraph twelve of the Supplemental Complaint. In answer to the second sentence of paragraph twelve of the Supplemental Complaint, this defendant admits that CHA filed a response on January 18, 1972; further answering defendant admits the accuracy of the quotation from said response set out in paragraph twelve.

13. Paragraph thirteen of the Supplemental Complaint does not refer to this defendant, and this defendant makes no response thereto.

14. In answer to the first sentence of paragraph fourteen of the Supplemental Complaint, defendant is without sufficient information or
