THIS MATTER coming on to be heard on the motion of Defendant, CHICAGO HOUSING AUTHORITY, by its attorneys and with the consent of the parties hereto and the Special Master to whom this matter has been referred being fully advised in the premises;

THE COURT having determined that the proposed Agreed Order is appropriate and in furtherance of the purposes of the judgment orders previously entered in this consolidated cause;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

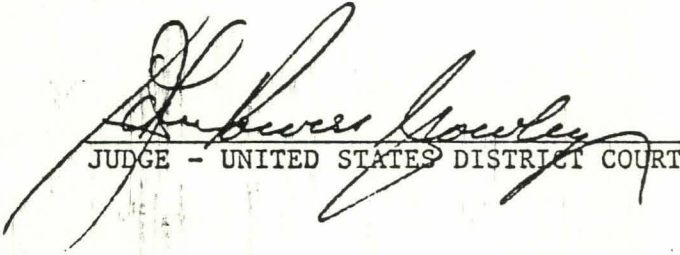
1. That the application and approval of housing assistance payments pursuant to §8 (Existing Housing) of §201(a) of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 for the Chicago Housing Authority in funding the Number Two Chicago Dwellings Association - Chicago Area Consolidated Leasing Program for some 389

dwelling units shall not be deemed to be in violation of Article III of this Court's Order of July 1, 1969, as amended by this Court's Order of May 5, 1975.

2. The Judgment Order entered herein on September 11, 1973 which directs the Defendant, United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), to use its best efforts to cooperate with the Chicago Housing Authority in its efforts to increase the supply of low-rent public housing in accordance with the Judgment Order entered herein on July 1, 1969, laws and applicable regulations, shall be deemed not to preclude HUD from approving an application of Chicago Housing Authority for housing assistance payments pursuant to Section 8 of § 201 (a) of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 for families in Chicago Area Coordinated Leasing Programs of the Number Two Chicago Dwellings Association.

3. Except as and to the extent specifically provided in this Order, this Court's Judgment Orders previously entered herein, as modified from time to time, remain in full force and effect, and this Court retains jurisdiction of this cause for all purposes.
