O R D E R

This matter coming on to be heard on the joint motion of plaintiffs and the defendant Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) pursuant to the provisions of Article X of the judgment order of July 1, 1969, whereby this Court has retained jurisdiction of this matter for all purposes including the purposes particularly enumerated therein, and

The Court having conferred with counsel for the parties and having determined that the several provisions of this modifying order are based upon relevant information with respect to the subject matter thereof, and that said provisions are appropriate and are consistent with and in furtherance of the reasons for the issuance of said judgment order,

It is hereby ordered:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other order of this Court, the defendant Department of Housing and Urban

Development (HUD) shall be free to allocate Section 8 existing housing funds to any multifamily housing development in the City of Chicago, regardless of location, having a mortgage insured by the Federal Housing Administration of HUD.

(2) Housing units for which Section 8 existing housing funds are made available under the preceding paragraph shall be offered for occupancy to members of the plaintiff class in accordance with arrangements agreed upon in writing from time to time by HUD and the plaintiffs. In the absence of such written agreement, not less than 20% of the housing units for which Section 8 existing housing funds are made available under the preceding paragraph shall be offered for occupancy to members of the plaintiff class in accordance with orders previously entered herein.

(3) Except as and to the extent specifically provided in this order, this Court's judgment orders previously entered herein, as previously modified, remain in full force and effect.

(4) This Court retains jurisdiction of this matter for all purposes, including enforcement and the issuance, upon proper notice and motion, of orders modifying or supplementing the terms of this order upon the presentation of relevant information with respect to proposed housing developments designed to achieve results consistent with judgment orders previously entered herein, material changes in conditions existing at the time of this order or any other matter.
