ORDER

This matter coming on to be heard upon the motion of plaintiffs for the approval of the employment of an expert pursuant to this Court's order dated May 19, 1978, and

The Court having heard the presentations of the parties and having determined that the proposed order is appropriate and in furtherance of the purposes of the judgment orders entered in this consolidated cause,

It is hereby ordered:

(1) In accordance with paragraph (1) of this Court's order of May 19, 1978, the employment of Richard F. Babcock, of Chicago, Illinois, to undertake the duties and responsibilities set forth in said order, is hereby approved.

(2) The date of the commencement of such employment shall be determined by the Special Master to whom this matter has been assigned, and notice of such date shall be given to each of the parties by the Master.

(3) The expert shall be directed by the Master to keep detailed records of time, rate of compensation paid to identified persons or personnel, and work discharged by such persons or personnel, and in the same manner to keep records of his own time and of the manner in which time is spent. Such records are to be accessible to the Special Master or the Court at any time during the period of employment.

(4) Except as and to the extent specifically provided in this order, this Court's judgment orders previously entered herein, as previously modified, and this Court's *memorandum opinion and* order of May 19, 1978, remain in full force and effect.

(5) This Court retains jurisdiction of this matter for all purposes.
