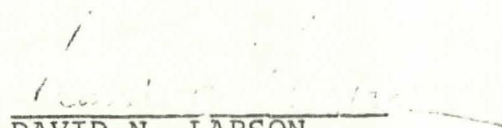

RE: Status of CD Program Expenditures

As discussed, attached please find a copy of the Comptroller's financial report on the city's Community Development Program as of January 31, 1979 and a table showing the status of drawdowns against our Treasury letter of credit for this program. We have also obtained the following totals for CD Year IV as of February 29, 1979:

Expenditures	\$ 5,201,367.23
Encumbrances	1,233,629.98
Accruals	781,975.00
	\$ 7,216,972.21

In addition, the city has incurred program obligations which are tantamount to legally binding commitments in a number of areas. For example, offers to purchase property in urban renewal project areas will result in program expenditures in excess of \$9 million for property acquisition, relocation, demolition and related costs.
