

The Court having determined that the several provisions of this order modifying said judgment order are based upon relevant information with respect to the subject matter thereof, and that said provisions are appropriate and are consistent with and in furtherance of the reasons for the issuance of said judgment order,

It is hereby ordered:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other order of this Court, including without limitation the provisions of Article III of said judgment order of July 1, 1969, CHA shall be free to propose to HUD, HUD shall be free to approve, and both defendants shall thereafter be free to carry out a development plan for 2223 units of public housing consisting of both new construction and acquisition and rehabilitation of existing structures as follows:

provided, however,

- (a) No new construction of family units in the Limited Public Housing Area shall commence until a like amount of new construction of family units in the General Public Housing Area has commenced;
- (b) No rehabilitation of family units in the Limited Public Housing Area shall commence until a like amount of rehabilitation of family units in the General Public Housing Area has commenced;
- (c) No new construction of elderly units shall commence until a proportionate amount (400 GPHA family units/ 886 elderly units) of new construction and rehabilitation of family units in the General Public Housing Area has commenced; and
- (d) No acquisition and rehabilitation of HUD owned properties shall commence until a proportionate amount (400 GPHA family units/537 HUD owned properties) of new construction and rehabilitation of family units in the General Public Housing Area has commenced.

2. Except as and to the extent specifically provided in this order, this Court's judgment orders previously entered herein, as previously modified, remain in full force and effect, including without limitation the provision of Article VIII of said judgment order of July 1, 1969, that "CHA shall use its best efforts to increase the supply of Dwelling Units as rapidly as possible in conformity with the provisions of this judgment order and shall take all steps necessary to that end..."

3. This Court retains jurisdiction of this matter for all purposes, including enforcement and the issuance, upon proper notice and motion, of orders modifying or supplementing the terms of this order upon the presentation of relevant information with respect to proposed housing developments designed to achieve results consistent with judgment orders previously entered herein, material changes in conditions existing at the time of this order or any other matter.
