O R D E R

On consideration of the "APPELLEES' JOINT MOTION TO DISMISS APPEAL", the "APPELLANTS' RESPONSE TO APPELLEES' JOINT MOTION TO DISMISS APPEAL" and the "APPELLEES' JOINT REPLY IN SUPPORT OF MOTION TO DISMISS APPEAL",

IT IS ORDERED that the "APPELLEES' JOINT MOTION TO DISMISS APPEAL" is taken with the case. The parties shall address the issue of appellate jurisdiction fully and completely in their respective briefs.

The briefing schedule is as follows:

1. The appellants shall file their joint brief and required short appendix on or before June 3, 2002.
2. The appellees shall file their joint brief on or before July 3, 2002.
3. The appellants shall file their joint reply brief, if any, on or before July 17, 2002.

NOTE: Circuit Rule 31(e) (amended Dec. 1, 2001) requires that counsel tender a digital copy of a brief, from cover to conclusion, at the time the paper copies are tendered for filing. The file must be a text-based PDF (portable document format), which contains the entire brief from cover to conclusion. Graphic-based scanned PDF images do not comply with this rule and will not be accepted by the clerk. Rule 26(c), Fed. R. App. P., which allows three additional days after service by mail, does not apply when the due dates for briefs are specifically set by order of this court. All briefs are due by the dates ordered.
