ORDER

This matter coming to be heard on the Joint Motion of Plaintiffs and Defendant Chicago Housing Authority for an order expanding the North Kenwood-Oakland Revitalizing Area and permitting development of family public housing units therein, and the Court having reviewed the parties' submissions; and

The Receiver, Daniel Levin and the Habitat Company, having represented to the Court that they have examined the proposal respecting the appropriate number of public housing units to be provided therein, and that they support the Joint Motion; and

The Court being cognizant that the principal remedial purpose of the Orders previously entered in these consolidated cases has been and is to provide plaintiff class families with desegregated housing opportunities; and

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The Court also being cognizant that on occasion it has permitted public or assisted housing to be provided in census tracts not within the General Public Housing Area upon a sufficient showing of "Revitalizing" circumstances such that a responsible forecast of economic integration, with a longer term possibility of racial desegregation, could be made; and

The Court being of the view that such a forecast can be made with respect to the proposed expansion of the North Kenwood-Oakland Revitalizing Area if the redevelopment plan described in the Motion is carried out;

Now, therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The Court designates the following portion of the City of Chicago as an expansion of the previously-designated North Kenwood-Oakland Revitalizing Area: ("Expansion Area"):

Beginning at the corner of Oakwood Boulevard and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive; north along Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive to East 37th Street; east on East 37th Street to South Rhodes Avenue; north on South Rhodes Avenue to East 35th Street; east along East 35th Street to the Illinois Central Railroad Right of Way; south along the Illinois Central Railroad Right of Way to Oakwood Boulevard; and west along Oakwood Boulevard to Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive.

2. The Receiver, previously appointed by the Court to develop scattered site public housing on behalf of the Defendant, Chicago Housing Authority, shall be free to develop up to 850 new units of non-elderly public housing within the

Expansion Area as part of a mixed income housing development generally consistent with the Master Plan previously approved by the Madden/Wells Working Group.

3. The parties may propose amendments to this order in the future to include site-specific eligibility criteria or other conditions respecting the development of public housing units in the expanded Expansion Area.
