**OPINION AND ORDER ON
PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR A
PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

The matter before the Court is Plaintiffs' Motion for a Preliminary Injunction. Plaintiffs request an order enjoining Defendant from enforcing PC 14A.50.020-25. The Court reviewed the parties' submissions and heard oral arguments from the parties on November 9, 2023. The Court has considered and balanced the factors in Elkhorn Baptist Church v. Brown, 366 Or 506, 466 P3d 30 (2020). Pursuant to ORCP 79 and Elkhorn, the Court finds that Plaintiffs made a sufficient showing to warrant preservation of the status quo so that, upon a final hearing, full relief may be granted. Therefore, the Court ORDERS as follows:

1. Plaintiff's Motion for a Preliminary Injunction is GRANTED. Defendant is ENJOINED from enforcing PC 14.A.50.020-25;
2. No bond shall be required pursuant to ORCP 82; and
3. This Order shall remain in effect during the pendency of the litigation, or until further order by the Court.
