The resolution of a motion to associate out-of-state counsel rests within the district court s discretion. SCR 42(6); Imperial Credit v. Eighth Jud. Dist. Ct., 130 Nev. 558, 331 P.3d 862 (2014). The district court s discretionary power is subject only to the test of reasonableness, which requires a determination of whether there is logic and justification for the result. Additionally, a district court may grant a motion to associate out-of-state counsel when an applicant meets all of the requirements for admission set forth in SCR 42. Id. In the present matter, Petitioner American Civil Liberties Union of Nevada filed a motion to associate Ming-Qi Chu. The Court finds that the requirements of SCR 42 have been met for Ming-Qi Chu. Ming-Qi Chu may practice in this Court for the purposes of this case only. Due to the aforementioned reasons, Petitioner s Unopposed Motion to Associate Counsel is hereby GRANTED. This Motion is hereby DENIED. Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 218F.720 grants the Legislative Counsel Bureau s Legal Division (LCB Legal) authority to provide the Legislature with legal representation in lawsuits and sets forth the standards and procedures for when and how to exercise those powers. Specifically, Subsection 1 provides: [W]hen deemed necessary or advisable to protect the official interests of the Legislature in any action or proceeding, the Legislative Commission . . . may direct the Legislative Counsel or the General Counsel and the Legal Division to appear in, commence, prosecute, defend or intervene in any action or proceeding before any court . . . This subsection makes clear that, as a general rule, it is the Legislature as a whole, acting through the Legislative Counsel or the General Counsel and the Legal Division, which may intervene When deemed necessary or advisable to protect the official interests of the Legislature. Id. Subsection 2 goes on to specify when the Legislature as a whole may intervene as it relates to acts of the Legislature. However, that subsection remains limited by the procedural constraints of Subsection 1. See NRS 218F.720, generally. In the present matter, seven Nevada legislators, Thaddeus J. Yurek III, Gregory Hafen II, Gregory Koenig, Alexis Hansen, Ira Hansen, Bert Gurr, and Melissa Hardy (the Legislators), filed a Motion to Intervene in this matter pursuant to NRS 218F.720(2)-(3), NRCP 24, NRS 12.130, and NRS 34.300. Therein, the Legislators argue that they have an unequivocal right to intervene in this matter pursuant to NRS 218F.720 and NRCP 24. On December 27, 2023, the Legislators filed an Errata to the Motion to Intervene,

			clarifying that the Legislators filed the Motion to Intervene as individual members of the Nevada Legislature and do not represent the entire Nevada Legislature as a legislative body. The Court finds that because the Legislators are acting as an independent minority of seven, as opposed to the entire legislative body, they do not have an unconditional right to intervene in this action. The individual legislators here, represented by private counsel, have no right or ability to intervene under NRS 218F.720. The scope of the intervention provisions at issue is evident from the language and context of the statute. <i>Gold Ridge Partners v. Sierra Pac. Power Co.</i>, 128 Nev. 495, 500 01, 285 P.3d 1059, 1062 63 (2012). Not only is LCB Legal not involved in the matter at bar, but the Legislators no longer purport to even be speaking on behalf of the Legislature to protect the body's official interests. For these reasons, this portion of the Motion is DENIED. Further, in deciding whether to permit such intervention, the court must consider whether the intervention will unduly delay or prejudice the adjudication of the original parties' rights. NRCP 24(b)(3). Permissive intervention is wholly discretionary with the [district] court and the court may refuse to allow intervention even where Rule 24(b)'s requirements are satisfied. <i>Hairr v. First Jud. Dist. Ct.</i>, 132 Nev. 180, 187, 368 P.3d 1198, 1202 03 (2016) (quoting 7C Charles Alan Wright et al., <i>Federal Practice & Procedure</i> 1913 (3d ed. 2007)). The seven individual Legislators do not explain what claim or defense they share with the main action. The failure to meet their burden to show they satisfy this threshold requirements is sufficient to deny the motion. Additionally, the Court agrees that granting this Motion would unduly delay [and] prejudice the adjudication of the original parties' rights, as a writ of mandamus is intended to provide speedy relief. Therefore, this portion of the Motion is also DENIED. Due to the aforementioned reasons, The Nevada Legislature's Motion to Intervene is hereby DENIED. Petitioner's counsel is directed to prepare a proposed order and to circulate it to the remaining parties for approval as to form and content before promptly submitting it to chambers at DC24Inbox@clarkcountycourts.us for signature.
