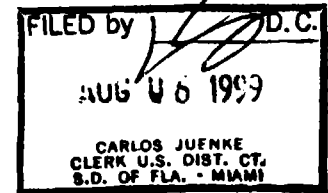

PREJUDICE



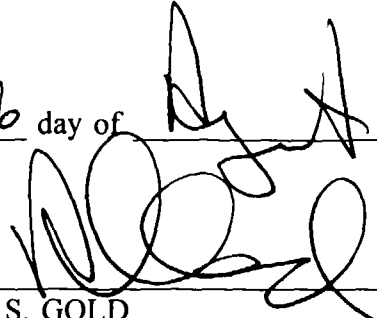
THIS MATTER is before the Court on the parties' filing of their Joint Motion for Dismissal With Prejudice. Having previously approved the Stipulated Settlement Agreement in this matter, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Joint Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED. In accordance with the Stipulated Settlement Agreement and Joint Motion, it is further ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that this case is dismissed with prejudice, and that this Court shall retain jurisdiction over this matter for 18 months from the effective date of the Settlement Agreement over the limited matters specified in Section G of the Stipulated Settlement Agreement.

This dismissal shall not be claimed to constitute nor be construed as a finding in favor or against any party nor as a finding of any of the allegations or defenses previously made in this case. This dismissal terminates this action for all time and all purposes, except that this Court shall retain continuing jurisdiction for 18 months from the effective date of the Stipulated Settlement Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A over the limited matters specified in Section G of the Stipulated Settlement Agreement.
