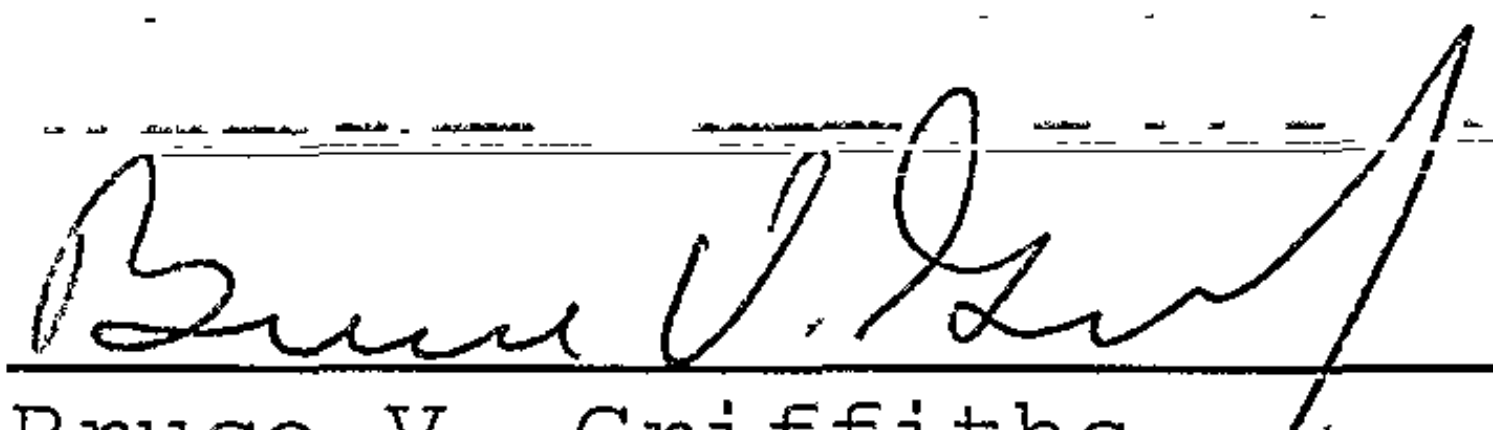
STIPULATION OF DISMISSAL
