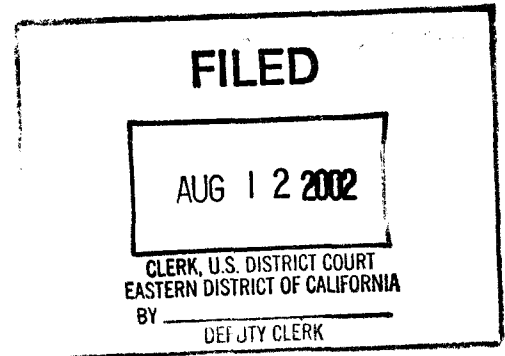

18 Pursuant to defendants' motion for clarification of this
19 court's order filed on July 24, 2002, the court notes as
20 follows:

21 1. The July 24, 2002 order concerned only the parties'
22 cross-motions for summary judgment as to subclasses one and two,
23 and not the claim of subclass three as to the jurisdiction-
24 stripping provisions of § 377 of IIRIRA. See July 24, 2002
25 Order at 2, n.1. Thus, the court's remedial order would, at
26 this time, concern only the members of subclasses one and two,

1 keeping in mind that subclass two includes all those who are
2 deemed to have filed for class membership pursuant to the final
3 regulations for the LIFE Act. See July 24, 2002 Order at 18
4 n.9.

5 2. As to subclass three, the parties' motions on that
6 matter were severed pending the resolution of a discovery
7 dispute. Presumably, because there appear to be no remaining
8 class representatives for subclass three, the parties will
9 either bring on a motion to dismiss or a motion to amend to add
10 new class representatives, at which time I will consider the
11 matter.

12 3. Concerning a remedy for subclasses one and two, the
13 parties shall meet and confer and proceed as directed in Section
14 III of this court's July 24, 2002 order, except that the time
15 periods set therein will run from the effective date of this
16 order.

17 IT IS SO ORDERED.

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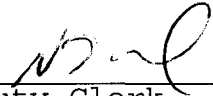
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
