O R D E R

On December 12, 1966, the three-judge court convened in this cause determined all constitutional and interrelated issues and formally ordered the defendants, among other things, to effect the desegregation of Alabama's penal institutions. On January 17, 1969, all matters remaining in the case at that time being cognizable by a single judge, the three-judge court was dissolved by formal order. A review of this case reveals that no further court action is necessary or is contemplated at this time. However, since the Court's order of December 12, 1966, requires continuing action on the part of the defendants and periodic reports to the Court, it is not appropriate to enter a formal order relinquishing jurisdiction of the subject matter or the parties. It is, however, appropriate that the Clerk of this Court, for record-keeping purposes, close this file and let the records of his office reflect that the case is "no longer pending."

It is, therefore, ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court, for record-keeping purposes, close this file and let his records

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ORDER

That part of the order made and entered in this case December 12, 1966, to the extent that it requires the Commissioner of the Board of Corrections for the State of Alabama to report to this Court every three months concerning the steps being taken and the progress being made in the State penal institutions and in the county and city jails, insofar as the desegregation of those institutions is concerned, is

ORDERED to be and the same is hereby amended so as to eliminate the necessity to file such reports with this Court every three months and, in lieu thereof, it is

ORDERED that the Commissioner of the Board of Corrections for the State of Alabama file such report with the Court on an annual basis commencing January 15, 1971.
