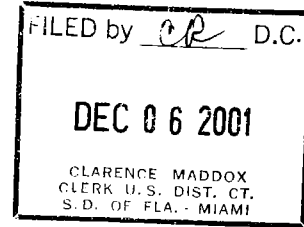

OMNIBUS ORDER DENYING CLASS MEMBERS' PRO SE MOTIONS

THIS MATTER is before the Court upon numerous *pro se* motions filed by William C. Eason and Michael T. Coolen, individuals who appear to be members of the class. This litigation was certified as a class action on July 25, 2000 and the class was represented by counsel long before that date. While class members may file their objections to the proposed settlement, which is currently pending, individual class members do not have standing to file *pro se* motions. Upon considering the motions, and being otherwise duly advised, it is therefore

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the following motions are DENIED:

1. "Emergency" Motion For Temporary Restraining Corder and/or Preliminary Injunction [DE#334]; and
2. Motion to Reject Revised Judgement [sic] Offer [DE#338], although the Court will consider this motion as an objection to the proposed settlement.
