PARTIAL INDIVIDUAL RELIEF
CONSENT ORDER

C.A. No. 88-5087 (WGB)

Plaintiff United States and defendants, State of New Jersey, et al. (“the State”), have jointly moved for the entry of an order to release funds from the Settlement Fund established by paragraph 28 of the Consent Decree entered on March 14, 1995, so that the four individuals listed below may receive the designated monetary relief to which they are entitled under the Consent Decree:

Dwayne Warfield	\$2,647.00
Connie Barlow	\$3,842.00
Carl Ross	\$2,054.00
Randy Johnson	\$1,485.88

The Consent Decree provides that these monetary awards are to be paid out of a fund, labeled by the Clerk of the District Court handling the funds as "Docket 88-5087 U.S. Account 02, Court Registry Investment System.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, THIS ____ DAY OF _____, 2006, THAT:

1. The Clerk of the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey shall, within seven (7) days, or as soon thereafter as the business of the Court allows, withdraw \$10,028.88 from the Court Registry Investment System Account Docket 88-5087, U.S. Account 02, and deposit the entire amount withdrawn into the Court registry for distribution in accordance with this Order;
2. The Clerk of the Court, shall, within ten (10) days or as soon thereafter as the business of the Court allows, issue a treasury check payable to the "State of New Jersey" for \$10,028.88;
3. The Clerk of the Court shall ensure that said treasury check is delivered to a representative of the State of New Jersey Department of Personnel when he or she picks the check up in person at the Clerk's Office in Trenton, New Jersey, on a date designated by the Clerk of the Court, no later than fourteen (14) days from the date of entry of this Order;
4. The State of New Jersey shall, within forty-five (45) calendar days of the date of the entry of this Order:
 - a) distribute to each individual listed above a check in the amount specified less any withholdings required by the Consent Decree, along with a letter, via certified mail, return receipt requested; and

- b) provide a copy of each letter, check and certified mail receipt to the United States.
5. If the State's certified mailing to any of the individuals listed above is unclaimed or returned for any reason within thirty days of receiving notice that the initial certified mailing was unclaimed or returned, the State shall:
- a) attempt to obtain the current address of the individual;
 - b) notify the United States, in writing, that the initial certified mailing was unclaimed or returned; and
 - c) re-mail the letter and check to the individual's current address, if one is obtained.
6. The State shall issue a 1099 form for 2006 to each individual listed above.

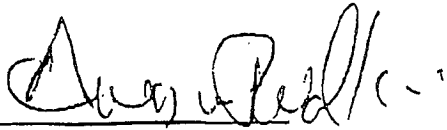
