Plaintiff EEOC's Motions to Compel Production of Documents and for Discovery Sanctions Against Defendant NCL America Inc. and against Defendant NCL Corporation Ltd. [Docket Nos. 119 and 121] (the "Motions to Compel") came on for hearing before this Court on September 14, 2007 at 2:00 pm. Connie Liem appeared for Plaintiff EEOC, Thomas Geisness appeared for Plaintiff-Intervenors, and Richard Rand and Christopher Yeh appeared for Defendants.

The Court having reviewed the Motions to Compel, the Memoranda In Opposition, and Reply Memoranda finds that Plaintiff did not comply with Local Rule 7.5 in filing its Motion to Compel Against NCL America Inc. [Docket No. 119]. As a sanction, the Court DENIES both Motions to Compel without prejudice. Defendants request for further sanctions is DENIED.
