STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT

22
23 Plaintiff DENNIS BUTLER ("BUTLER"), on behalf of himself and on behalf of the Settlement
24 Class defined herein, and Defendants SANTA CRUZ COUNTY and SANTA CRUZ COUNTY
25 SHERIFF STEVE ROBBINS, in his individual and official capacities, (hereinafter collectively referred
26 to as "COUNTY"), by and through their respective counsel, hereby submit the following Stipulation of
27 Settlement.

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I.**RECITALS**

On or about February 14, 2007, BUTLER filed a Class Action Complaint against Defendants. The complaint alleged that the COUNTY's practices relating to strip searching certain arrestees and inmates violated rights of these individuals guaranteed by the Fourth Amendment to the United States Constitution and Article I, Section 1 of the California Constitution and were in violation of certain California statutes, including Penal Code section 4030, in several respects: the complaint alleged that blanket strip searches were being performed on pre-arraignment arrestees for whom there was no reasonable suspicion that they may be attempting to conceal contraband; that strip searches were performed repeatedly prior to arraignment, in groups where others, not participating in the searches, could observe the persons being strip searched; and that strip searches were being performed on persons after they were ordered released by the Court following their arraignments.

The Parties conducted discovery that included exchange of documents, interrogatories, depositions, and inspection of the COUNTY's jail facilities.

Following the filing of this Class Action Complaint, the Sheriff's Office issued revised strip search policies. Plaintiff is satisfied that, as of July 14, 2007, the Sheriff's Office strip search policies are in conformance with state and federal law.

On December 4 and 5, 2007, and on February 27 and 28, 2008, the Parties participated in mediation sessions presided over by the Honorable Raul A. Ramirez (United States District Court Judge, retired) and agreed to this Stipulation of Settlement which, subject to the approval of the Court, settles this action in the manner and upon the terms set forth below and fully resolves the dispute.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, by and between the Parties as follows:

II.**DEFINITIONS**

1. "Administrator" means Gilardi and Co., P.O. Box 8060, San Rafael, CA 94912-8060, to be appointed by the Court to provide notice to the members of the class and to review and determine the validity and value of claims submitted by Settlement Class Members ("SCMs"), according to the

1 procedures set forth herein.

2 2. The "Bar Date" is the date established by the Court by which any SCM who wishes to
3 receive payment pursuant to the Stipulation of Settlement must file his/her Claim Form(s), objections to
4 this Stipulation of Settlement, or request to be excluded from the class ("OPT-OUT"). The Bar Date
5 shall be one hundred and twenty (120) days after the Class Notice (defined below) is first published in a
6 newspaper serving the Santa Cruz County area.

7 3. "Charge List" means the list of charges attached hereto as Exhibit 1.

8 4. The "Claim Form" is the form required to make a claim for payment under this settlement.
9 A copy of the proposed Claim Form is attached as Exhibit 2.

10 5. "Class Counsel" means The Law Office of Mark E. Merin, and Mark E. Merin, attorney,
11 2001 P Street, Suite 100, Sacramento, CA 95811.

12 6. The "Class Notice" means the notice in the form attached hereto as Exhibit 3 (Notice by
13 Mail) and includes such other summary notice(s) to be published in newspapers serving the Santa Cruz
14 County area and posted in the Santa Cruz County Main Jail.

15 7. The "Class Period" is February 14, 2005, through and including July 14, 2007.

16 8. The "Database" is the information provided in hard copy and/or electronic form by
17 COUNTY to the Administrator and Class Counsel which includes, to the extent practicable, the name,
18 last known address(es), date of birth, social security number, date(s) of booking, charge(s) and
19 information reflecting whether the SCM was on parole or searchable probation at the time of booking of
20 all SCMs booked and housed at a COUNTY correctional facility during the Class Period.

21 9. "Debts Owed" shall mean any financial obligation of an SCM which would be collected
22 by the County of Santa Cruz or its agents for any amounts owed to the COUNTY, including but not
23 limited to unpaid work furlough fees, any amounts owed to the COUNTY or State of California for
24 unpaid child support or for amounts paid from the Victims of Violent Crime Fund as a result of criminal
25 conduct of an SCM, and any amounts owed by any SCM for restitution ordered by the Santa Cruz
26 County Superior Court.

27 10. The "Effective Date" means the date upon which a judgment entered by the Court
28 approving the Stipulation of Settlement becomes final. The judgment will be deemed final only upon

1 expiration of the time to appeal or, if a Notice of Appeal is filed, upon exhaustion of all appeals and
 2 petitions for Writs of Certiorari.

3 11. "Non-VDW Misdemeanor Offense" means a misdemeanor, infraction, ordinance or lesser
 4 offense arrest charge not listed on the Charge List.

5 12. "Non-VDW Felony Offense" means a felony arrest charge not listed on the Charge List.

6 13. "VDW Misdemeanor Offense" means a misdemeanor, infraction, ordinance or lesser
 7 offense charge listed on the Charge List.

8 14. "VDW Felony Offense" means a felony arrest charge listed on the Charge List.

9 15. An "Opt-Out" is any potential SCM who files a timely request for exclusion as specified
 10 in Paragraph 54.

11 16. "Released Persons" means SANTA CRUZ COUNTY, all of its agencies, departments and
 12 divisions, SANTA CRUZ COUNTY SHERIFF STEVE ROBBINS, and their predecessors, successors,
 13 and/or assigns, together with past, present, and future officials, employees, representatives, attorneys
 14 and/or agents of SANTA CRUZ COUNTY or the Santa Cruz County Sheriff's Department, including but
 15 not limited to all employees of the Santa Cruz County Main Jail and other Santa Cruz County
 16 correctional facilities.

17 17. The "Settlement Class" means all of those persons who are members of the following
 18 defined classes who, during the Class Period, were booked at a Santa Cruz County correctional facility,
 19 assigned to a housing unit, and strip searched at that facility prior to arraignment on the charges for
 20 which they were booked and/or strip searched upon return to jail after being ordered released by the
 21 Court:

22 a. **PRE-ARRAIGNMENT STRIP SEARCH CLASS:**

23 The following persons shall be referred to as the "PRE-ARRAIGNMENT STRIP
 24 SEARCH CLASS": (1) All arrestees booked into a Santa Cruz County
 25 correctional facility during the Class Period on non-VDW Felony Offenses or non-
 26 VDW Misdemeanor Offenses, who were assigned to a housing unit and who
 27 underwent one or more STRIP SEARCHES prior to arraignment on the charges on
 28 which they were booked excluding: 1) persons who, at the time of such Class

Period booking were on parole and, 2) persons who, within the seven (7) years prior to such Class Period booking, had been arrested in SANTA CRUZ COUNTY on two (2) or more occasions on VDW offenses, whether Felony or Misdemeanor Offenses.

b. POST RELEASE STRIP SEARCH CLASS:

The following persons shall be referred to as the "POST RELEASE STRIP SEARCH CLASS": Any person who, during the Class Period, was ordered released by the Court within eight (8) days of his or her booking in any Santa Cruz County correctional facility and was strip searched upon return to a Santa Cruz County correctional facility after the Court ordered that person to be released.

18. "Strip Search," as used in this Stipulation of Settlement, means a search that requires a person to remove or arrange some or all of his or her clothing so as to permit a visual inspection of the underclothing, breasts, buttocks, or genitalia of such person.

19. A "Settlement Class Member" ("SCM") means any member of the Settlement Class, including representatives, successors and assigns, who does not file a valid and timely Request for Exclusion as provided in Paragraph 54 of this Stipulation of Settlement.

20. "Special Master" shall mean the Honorable Raul A. Ramirez (Ret.) appointed by the Court to preside over this Stipulation of Settlement. The Special Master shall have the power to make decisions in all matters pertaining to the administration and enforcement of the Stipulation of Settlement, and to resolve all disputes between the Parties pertaining to the Stipulation of Settlement. All orders and directives of the Special Master shall be subject to review by the Court upon request of any party. All fees and expenses of the Special Master shall be paid from funds allocated for Claims Administration.

III.

TERMS AND EFFECT OF STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT

21. This Stipulation of Settlement is for settlement purposes only, and neither the fact of, nor any provision contained in this Stipulation of Settlement or its exhibits, nor any action taken hereunder shall constitute, be construed as, or be admissible in evidence as any admission of the validity of any claim or any fact alleged by the Plaintiff or SCMs in this action or in any other pending action of any

1 wrongdoing, fault, violation of law, or liability of any kind on the part of Defendants or admission by
2 Defendants of any claim or allegation made in this action or in any other action, nor as an admission by
3 the Plaintiff, SCMs or Class Counsel of the validity of any fact or defense asserted against them in this
4 action or in any other action. Defendants deny all allegations of wrongdoing and deny any liability to
5 Plaintiff or to any other Class Members. The Parties have agreed that, in order to avoid long and costly
6 litigation, this controversy should be settled pursuant to the terms of this settlement, subject to the
7 approval of the Court.

8 22. The Santa Cruz County Sheriff's Department and/or the Santa Cruz County Information
9 Technology Department will provide the name, last known address(es), and other necessary personal
10 information of all SCMs to Class Counsel and the Claims Administrator. In addition, in conjunction with
11 conducting due diligence to determine award reductions as discussed below, the Santa Cruz County
12 Sheriff's Department and/or the Santa Cruz County Information Technology Department will obtain
13 criminal history information from the Criminal Justice Information System or other applicable database
14 operated and maintained by the California Department of Justice. This personal and criminal history
15 information, which will be included in the Database, is considered privileged and confidential, and will
16 remain as such notwithstanding transmission to Class Counsel and the Claims Administrator or the
17 Claims Administrator's agents. The parties will use this personal and criminal history information only
18 for purposes of satisfying their rights, duties, and obligations under this Stipulation of Settlement. After
19 all SCMs have been paid pursuant to this Stipulation of Settlement, Class Counsel and the Claims
20 Administrator will assure that all personal and criminal history information contained in the Database
21 and obtained pursuant to this paragraph will be destroyed. The COUNTY, the Santa Cruz County
22 Sheriff's Department, and the Santa Cruz County Information Technology Department shall be immune
23 from any civil liability associated with obtaining the personal and criminal history information discussed
24 herein and transmitting it to Class Counsel and the Claims Administrator or its agents. No SCM shall be
25 permitted to sue the COUNTY, the Santa Cruz County Sheriff's Department, or the Santa Cruz County
26 Information Technology Department for alleged damages associated with the disclosure of the personal
27 or criminal history information discussed in this paragraph, and any such claims are hereby considered
28 released per paragraph 26 of this Stipulation of Settlement.

23. On or about the Effective Date, the Parties will submit all appropriate papers to dismiss Case No. C 07-00941 JF in the United States District Court for the Northern District of California, San Jose Division.

24. The Parties agree, solely for the purpose of this settlement and its implementation, that the action shall proceed as a class action, with the Settlement Class as defined in Paragraph 17, and that attorneys for the Settlement Class are Class Counsel as defined in Paragraph 5; but if such settlement fails to be approved or otherwise fails to be consummated, then this Stipulation of Settlement is hereby withdrawn.

25. SCMs who comply with the requirements set forth in this Stipulation of Settlement will be paid specified sums determined by the procedures set forth herein in full satisfaction of all claims.

26. This Stipulation of Settlement, as of the Effective Date, resolves in full all claims against the Released Persons by BUTLER and all of the SCMs, involving alleged violations of their rights guaranteed by the Fourth Amendment to the United States Constitution, or by Article 1, Section 1 of the California Constitution, or of alleged violations of California Penal Code Section 4030, California Civil Code Sections 52 and 52.1 or any other federal, state or local law, regulation, duty or obligation which are based upon, or could be based upon, or arise from the facts alleged in the complaint for damages filed in Case No. C 07-00941 JF in the United States District Court, for the Northern District of California, San Jose Division. When the Stipulation of Settlement is final, as of the Effective Date, all SCMs and BUTLER hereby release all such claims.

27. The Parties agree that the Court, by preliminarily approving the Stipulation of Settlement, will be certifying the Settlement Class as defined in Paragraph 17 as the Settlement Class, subject to final approval of the settlement at the Fairness Hearing, and that the Court shall retain exclusive and continuing jurisdiction of the action, Parties, SCMs, Special Master and the Administrator to interpret and enforce the terms, conditions and obligations under this agreement.

28. This is a full and final Release applying to all unknown and unanticipated injuries, deaths or damages arising out of the events described in the Complaint in Case No. C 07-00941 JF filed in the United States District Court for the Northern District of California, San Jose Division, as well as those now known or disclosed. BUTLER and each SCM waives all rights or benefits which he or she now has

1 or in the future may have under the terms of California Civil Code section 1542, which reads:

2 "A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not
3 know or suspect to exists in his or her favor at the time of executing the
4 release, which if known by him or her must have materially effected his or
her settlement with the debtor."

5 29. As of the Effective Date of this Stipulation of Settlement, the SCMs, including BUTLER,
6 hereby waive any and all rights to pursue, initiate, prosecute, or commence any action or proceeding
7 before any Court, administrative agency or other tribunal, or to file any complaint with regard to acts of
8 commission or omission by the Released Persons respecting such SCMs with respect to any strip search
9 by Defendants during their confinement at any of the COUNTY's jail facilities which occurred during
10 the Class Period.

11 30. This Stipulation of Settlement contains all of the terms and conditions agreed upon by the
12 Parties hereto regarding the subject matter of the instant proceeding, and no oral agreement entered into
13 at any time nor any written agreement entered into prior to the execution of this Stipulation of Settlement
14 shall be deemed to exist, or to bind the Parties hereto, or to vary the terms and conditions contained
15 herein, except as expressly provided herein.

16 31. Each SCM shall be deemed to have submitted to the jurisdiction of the Court.

17 32. No Opt-Out shall share in any monetary benefits provided by this Stipulation of
18 Settlement.

19 33. This agreement is subject to and conditioned upon the final approval of this Stipulation of
20 Settlement and the issuance of the final order and judgment of dismissal, by the United States District
21 Court, Northern District of California, providing the below-specified relief, which relief shall be pursuant
22 to the terms and conditions of this Stipulation of Settlement and the Parties' performance of their
23 continuing obligations hereunder. The order and judgment will be deemed final only upon expiration of
24 the time to appeal, or, if a Notice of Appeal is filed, upon exhaustion of all appeals and petitions for writs
25 of certiorari. Such final order and judgment shall:

- 26 a. Dismiss with prejudice all complaints in the action as to the Released Persons;
27 b. Order that all SCMs are enjoined from asserting against any Released Person any
28 and all claims that the SCMs have, had, or may have in the future arising out of the

1 facts alleged in the complaint;

- 2 c. Release each Released Person from the claims that any SCM has, had or may have
3 in the future, against such Released Person arising out of the facts alleged in the
4 related complaints;
- 5 d. Determine that this Stipulation of Settlement is entered into in good faith, is
6 reasonable, fair and adequate, and is in the best interest of the Class; and
- 7 e. Reserve the Court's continuing and exclusive jurisdiction over the Parties to this
8 Stipulation of Settlement, including Defendants and all SCMs, to administer,
9 supervise, construe and enforce the Stipulation of Settlement in accordance with
10 the terms for the mutual benefit of all the Parties.

11 34. The Parties will take all necessary and appropriate steps to obtain preliminary approval of
12 the Stipulation of Settlement, final approval of the settlement, and dismissal of the action with prejudice.
13 If the Court finally approves this Stipulation of Settlement, and if there is an appeal from such decision,
14 the COUNTY will actively cooperate with Plaintiffs in joint efforts to defend the Stipulation of
15 Settlement.

16 IV.

17 **RESOLUTION AND PAYMENT OF CLAIMS FOR DAMAGES**

18 35. The Parties have agreed that certain sums will be paid by or on behalf of the COUNTY to
19 resolve all claims of all SCMs as described in Paragraph 25, and that the total of all such sums shall not
20 exceed Three Million, Eight Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$3,875,000.00), including the fees
21 and costs of Class Counsel and the cost of administration of this settlement.

22 36. Class Counsel and the SCMs, by and through Representative Plaintiff BUTLER, have
23 determined that the following distribution of the sum described in Paragraph 34 is appropriate, in which
24 determination the Released Persons acquiesce: (1) Up to Two Million, Six Hundred Thousand Dollars
25 (\$2,600,000.00) will be allocated to pay verified claims of the SCMs; (2) Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars
26 (\$75,000.00) will be allocated to compensate Representative Plaintiff BUTLER; (3) Nine Hundred Fifty
27 Thousand Dollars (\$950,000.00) will be allocated to pay Class Counsel's fees and costs; (4) Up to Two
28 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) will be allocated to pay the costs of administration,

including all notices to the classes and processing, administration and payment of the SCMs' claims. Distribution of the settlement amount is subject to the following terms and conditions of this Stipulation of Settlement.

37. No payment shall be made to eligible SCMs before the Effective Date. Claims may be processed between the date of preliminary Court approval and the Effective Date. Claims will only be paid after all verified Claims have been calculated and all disputes relating to Claims have been resolved.

38. No payment shall be paid to Class Counsel for fees and costs before the Effective Date as more fully described in Paragraph 10.

39. Representative Plaintiff BUTLER's payment of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00) shall be made to him, care of Class Counsel, within thirty (30) days of the Effective Date.

40. The Parties agree to make an application to the Court to appoint the Administrator as an officer of the Court for the purpose of implementing the terms of the Stipulation of Settlement. The Administrator shall be subject to judicial immunity to the fullest extent permitted by law.

V.

PROCEDURES FOR RECEIVING PAYMENT UNDER THIS SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

41. All members of the PRE-ARRAIGNMENT STRIP SEARCH CLASS, as defined in Paragraph 17(a), booked during the Class Period, upon return of a verified Claim Form, shall receive the following:

- a. Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each booking, up to two (2), on a non-VDW Misdemeanor charge, unless, within seven (7) years prior to the qualifying booking, the SCM had been arrested on two or more occasions on VDW offenses, whether Felony or Misdemeanor Offenses in Santa Cruz County or, at the time of such booking, was on parole or searchable probation;
- b. Twelve Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,250.00) for each booking, up to two (2), on a non-VDW Felony charge unless, within seven (7) years prior to the qualifying booking, the SCM had been arrested on two or more occasions on VDW offenses, whether Felony or Misdemeanor Offenses in Santa Cruz County or, at the time of such booking, was on parole or searchable probation;
- c. Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350.00) if the SCM was booked on a non-VDW Felony Offense or a non-VDW Misdemeanor Offense and was on probation, the conditions of which included a requirement to submit to a search, and who was not arrested in Santa Cruz County on two or more occasions on VDW offenses, whether Felony or Misdemeanor Offenses within the seven (7) years proceeding the qualifying booking.

42. All members of the POST RELEASE STRIP SEARCH CLASS, as defined in paragraph 17(b), shall receive One Thousand, Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,250.00), if the offense on which the person was booked was a misdemeanor or Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) if the offense on which the person was booked was a Felony. Regardless of the number of times a person was strip-searched following the release order, persons in the POST RELEASE STRIP SEARCH CLASS will receive only one payment for any and all POST RELEASE STRIP SEARCHES. Persons in the POST RELEASE STRIP SEARCH CLASS may also receive payments if they qualify for membership in the PRE-ARRAIGNMENT STRIP SEARCH CLASS.

43. In addition to the sums specified in paragraphs 41 and 42, all SCMs in the PRE-ARRAIGNMENT STRIP SEARCH CLASS will become eligible to receive additional sums, referred to as "Enhancements" of Five Hundred Dollars for each applicable condition if they were under 21 or over 60 at the time of the qualifying STRIP SEARCH, had a physical or mental disability at the time of strip search, or were pregnant at the time of strip search. SCMs in the PRE-ARRAIGNMENT STRIP SEARCH CLASS will receive enhancements of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) each if, at the time of the strip search, the SCM was menstruating.

44. In addition to the payments described in paragraphs 41, 42, and 43, SCMs in the PRE-ARRAIGNMENT STRIP SEARCH CLASS may become eligible to receive amounts, to be determined by negotiations between Class Counsel and COUNTY's counsel, of not less than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or more than Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) if, at the time they submit a timely Claim Form to the Administrator, they also submit medical or psychological records or reports from licensed physicians or psychologists, marriage and family counselors, or clinical social workers establishing that, within 90 days after the strip search which is the subject of their claim, they received treatment for a physical, emotional or psychological injury caused by the strip search. All documentation of such claimed injuries will be provided to counsel for the COUNTY, who will be afforded a reasonable period of time to investigate each such claim, including taking depositions and obtaining additional records. In the event that Class Counsel and COUNTY's counsel cannot agree on an amount to resolve the claim of any SCM described in this paragraph, all documentation pertaining to that SCM's claim shall be submitted to the Special Master, along with each counsel's proposed amount for an award, and

1 the Special Master shall determine the amount of the award, based upon the documents submitted to him.

2 45. The total of all payments described in paragraphs 41 through 44, shall not exceed the sum
3 of Two Million, Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,600,000.00).

4 46. The Administrator shall determine whether or not a person who submitted a Claim Form
5 is an SCM and shall reject claims from persons who are not SCMs.

6 47. After the final approval of the Stipulation of Settlement, as specified in paragraph 33, the
7 Administrator will determine the total amount owed to all SCMs who have filed valid Claim Forms. In
8 the event that the total amount owed for claims made by SCMs exceeds the amount of Two Million, Six
9 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,600,000.00), the Administrator will reduce the amount which each SCM
10 will receive, proportionately, so that the total of all payments does not exceed the maximum available
11 payment for the claims. Upon determination of the total of all amounts to be paid to all SCMs, the
12 Administrator will notify the Parties of the amounts necessary to satisfy all SCMs' claims and COUNTY
13 will cause sufficient funds to be deposited in the Administrator's account within thirty (30) days of such
14 notice to permit the Administrator to pay the verified claims

15 48. If the total amount of the verified claims of all SCMs does not exceed Two Million, Six
16 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,600,000.00), the difference between the total value of all such claims and
17 Two Million, Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,600,000.00), shall not be paid pursuant to this
18 Stipulation of Settlement.

19 49. Any SCM who fails to submit a Claim Form completed in accordance with the
20 instructions contained therein by the Bar Date or any other Court mandated extension, shall be forever
21 barred from receiving any payment pursuant to this Stipulation of Settlement. Such SCM shall, in all
22 other respects, be bound by all of the terms and conditions of this Stipulation of Settlement, and the
23 judgment entered herein, including but not limited to the release of all Released Persons of all claims
24 resolved herein. The Administrator will determine the value to be assigned to the claim of each eligible
25 SCM based upon the Administrator's review of the Claim Forms and the information in the database
26 provided by Defendants.

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VI.**AWARD REDUCTIONS**

50. Any recovery for which an SCM who submits a claim is eligible shall be reduced by 50% if the SCM was sentenced and confined in any California County jail or in a California State Penitentiary or Correctional Institution for any period of time during the five (5) years preceding a qualifying booking during the applicable Class Period.

51. All awards to SCMs shall be subject to deduction for any Debts Owed as described in Paragraph 9, up to a maximum of Fifty Percent (50%) of the net recovery after any reduction as provided in Paragraph 50. After the Administrator has provided the COUNTY and Class Counsel with a list of qualifying SCMs, the COUNTY shall provide to the Administrator and Class Counsel a list of all qualified SCMs who have Debts Owed and who submit valid claims, with the amount and nature of the Debt Owed. The Administrator shall deduct from each SCM's award the amount of the specified Debt Owed, up to a maximum of Fifty Percent (50%) of the net recovery after any reduction as provided in Paragraph 50. At the time it pays any amount of money to any SCM pursuant to the terms of this Stipulation of Settlement, the Administrator shall reduce that SCM's payment and forward to the COUNTY or other appropriate agency the amounts deducted from that SCM's award based upon the unpaid Debts Owed. Copies of the information related to the Debts Owed and the reduction of the awards shall be provided to the SCMs with copies to Class Counsel. Any SCM may submit a written objection to the Debts Owed within thirty (30) days of the date that settlement checks are distributed. The written objection shall specify the grounds for the objection and copies shall be sent to Class Counsel and the COUNTY's Counsel, or the COUNTY's designee. In the event that the SCM, Class Counsel and the COUNTY's Counsel or its designee cannot informally resolve the objection, the objection will be submitted to the Special Master. The fees of the Special Master for resolving such objections shall be paid as a cost of administration of the settlement.

VII.**GENERAL CLAIM PROCEDURES**

52. To receive payment an SCM shall be required to submit to the Administrator an executed Claim Form, signed under penalty of perjury.

53. The Claim Form shall be submitted by first class mail and shall be deemed submitted upon the date of the postmark thereon.

54. SCMs who submit claims and whose names appear on the database will be paid by mail at the address specified on the Claim Form. Payments to SCMs who are confined to a Santa Cruz County jail facility at the time of payment will be made to that SCM's jail commissary account.

VIII.

EXCLUSION FROM THE SETTLEMENT CLASS

55. Any potential SCM who wishes to be excluded from one of the Settlement Classes described in Paragraph 17 must file a Request for Exclusion (Opt-Out) with the Clerk of the Court, on or before the Bar Date or as the Court may otherwise direct. Representative Plaintiff BUTLER may not request exclusion pursuant to this paragraph. Any potential SCM who does not timely file a Request for Exclusion shall conclusively be deemed to have become an SCM and to be bound by this Stipulation of Settlement and by all subsequent proceedings, orders, and judgments herein.

56. Any SCM who does not elect to be excluded from the Settlement Class may, but need not, enter an appearance through his or her own attorney. SCMs who do not enter an appearance will be represented by Class Counsel.

57. The COUNTY may, in its sole discretion, withdraw from the Stipulation of Settlement if the number of Opt-Outs exceeds fifteen (15). The COUNTY will advise the Court of its election no less than fifteen (15) days prior to the Fairness Hearing. If the COUNTY withdraws pursuant to this provision of this Stipulation of Settlement, the Stipulation of Settlement will be null and void.

IX.

OBJECTING TO THE PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

58. Any SCM who does not elect to be excluded from the Settlement Class may, but need not, submit comments or objections to the proposed settlement. The Court will enter an appropriate order setting forth the procedure for SCMs to submit comments or objections to the proposed settlement.

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X.

ATTORNEYS' FEES AND COSTS

59. Class Counsel shall receive a total award of Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$950,000.00) for attorneys' fees, costs and expenses incident to prosecuting this action, which includes any costs and fees incurred in seeking final approval of this Stipulation of Settlement and the defense thereof in any Court or jurisdiction. Payment will be made as follows: Four Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$475,000.00) will be paid within Thirty (30) days of the Effective Date by check made payable to the Law Office of Mark E Merin and delivered to Class Counsel at 2001 P Street, Suite 100, Sacramento, CA 95811. The remaining Four Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$475,000.00) will be paid at the time of distribution of settlement funds to the SCMs by delivery of a check made payable and delivered as specified above. This award is subject to the approval of the Court.

XI.

NOTICE

60. Notice to SCMs defined in Paragraph 17, including a Claim Form with a postage pre-paid return envelope, shall be by first class mail, postage prepaid, to all individuals whose addresses are on record in databases maintained by the Santa Cruz County Sheriff's Office and/or the Santa Cruz County Information Technology Department, or to such other, better addresses identified by the Administrator. Such information will be provided to the Administrator as referenced in Paragraph 22. Both Parties and the Administrator will exercise their best efforts to update and to verify addresses, including but not limited to addresses of SCMs who are incarcerated. This paragraph shall not limit further appropriate efforts to provide notice.

61. Follow-up reminder post cards shall be delivered by first class mail 45 days after initial notice is given to the last known address of all SCMs who have not returned a Claim Form by that date. Such reminder post cards need not be sent to SCMs whose original notice and Claim Form were returned as undeliverable by the United States Postal Service and for whom the Administrator has no alternative address.

62. The Administrator shall cause a summary notice to be published in the Santa Cruz Sentinel and in the San Jose Mercury News, and in such free additional publications calculated to reach

the SCMs, once per week in each of three consecutive weeks, in a form and manner agreed to by the Parties, describing this settlement, the claims procedure, and the procedure to object and/or to Opt-Out of the settlement. If the Parties cannot agree on the wording of the summary notice, the Special Master will determine the content of the summary notice to be published. Copies of the summary notice shall be posted in the Santa Cruz County Main Jail in areas accessible to detainees during the Claims Period.

63. Announcements summarizing the proposed settlement in English and Spanish will be made on three (3) radio stations to be determined in consultation with the Administrator at least three (3) times during a week for three consecutive weeks.

XII.

ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS

64. All reasonable costs incurred in the administration of this Stipulation of Settlement including but not limited to, the fees of the Administrator, costs of disseminating notice to Class Members by mail, publication, or other means agreed to by the Parties, costs of producing Notice to be posted, costs of reviewing and evaluating claims, including the cost of distribution of the monetary payments to the class members, fees of the Special Master for services rendered in connection with Paragraph 20, and any additional ancillary administration fees, will be paid up to the total amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) allocated for these expenses.

65. Following preliminary Court approval of the Stipulation of Settlement, the Administrator shall submit monthly invoices to the Risk Management Unit of the County of Santa Cruz, with copies to Class Counsel and the COUNTY's Counsel, for services rendered and for expense reimbursement. All invoices will indicate the dates upon which services were performed, the titles of the employees performing the services, the number of hours worked by each title on each date, the hourly rate for each such title, and the total fee for the services performed. The rates will be in accordance with the agreement between the Parties and the Claims Administrator.

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66. In the event that the total charges against the Administration Fund does not exceed Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) after all Claims have been paid, and all Administration has been completed, any remaining funds allocated for Claims Administration under this Stipulation of Settlement will be considered discharged and not payable.

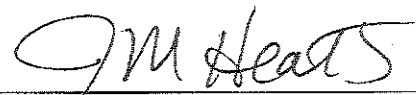

A class action lawsuit is presently pending in the United States District Court, Northern District of California. If the proposed Settlement described below receives final approval, people who were subjected to a strip search in a Santa Cruz County correctional facility prior to arraignment on certain charges, and/or subjected to a strip search after being ordered released by the Court, will be eligible to receive money from the settlement fund.

There is now pending in the United States District Court in and for the Northern District of California a class action lawsuit involving the classes of persons defined below (Settlement Class Members – "SCMs"):

PRE-ARRAIGNMENT STRIP SEARCH CLASS: The following persons shall be referred to as the "PRE-ARRAIGNMENT STRIP SEARCH CLASS": (1) All arrestees booked into a Santa Cruz County correctional facility during the Class Period on Felony or Misdemeanor charges not relating to violence, drugs or weapons ("non-VDW charges"), who were assigned to a housing unit and who underwent one or more STRIP SEARCHES prior to arraignment on the charges on which they were booked excluding: 1) persons who, at the time of such Class Period booking were on parole and, 2) persons who, within the seven (7) years prior to such Class Period booking, had been arrested in SANTA CRUZ COUNTY on two or more occasions on VDW Felony or Misdemeanor Offenses.

POST RELEASE STRIP SEARCH CLASS: The following persons shall be referred to as the "POST RELEASE STRIP SEARCH CLASS": Any person who, during the Class Period, was ordered released by the Court within eight (8) days of his or her booking in any Santa Cruz County correctional facility and was strip searched upon return to a Santa Cruz County correctional facility after the Court ordered that person to be released.

This Notice is to inform you that a settlement has been proposed in this action and that, as a potential class member, your rights may be affected by the settlement. This Notice also summarizes the terms and effect of the proposed settlement, what you can do to participate in it, and how you can obtain money under the settlement.

SUMMARY OF THE PROPOSED TERMS

A Settlement Agreement ("Settlement") was entered into after negotiations between the parties, conducted with the assistance of a third party mediator. The Parties are requesting that the Court approve the Settlement.

A. Parties to the Settlement.

The parties to the Settlement are the Plaintiff named in Butler, et al. v. County of Santa Cruz, et al., United States District Court, Northern District, Case No. C 07-00941 JF on behalf of himself and the Settlement Class, and various defendants including the County of Santa Cruz. Counsel for the class is Mark E. Merin, The Law Office of Mark E. Merin, 2001 P Street, Suite 100, Sacramento, CA 95814.

B. Monetary Terms of Settlement**1. Class Fund and Related Expenses.**

Defendants shall pay a maximum of \$3,875,000 under the terms of the settlement that will hereafter be referred to as the Settlement Fund.

Class Counsel will seek an award of \$950,000 of the Settlement Fund as attorney's fees and costs for recovering the Settlement Fund for the Class Members. Up to \$250,000 of the Settlement Fund may be used for costs of claims administration. Up to \$2,600,000 may be used to pay valid claims. The representative plaintiff will receive a payment of \$75,000, subject to Court approval.

2. Payments to Class Members Who File Claims.

Money for the class will be paid out based on a distribution formula, subject to payments being proportionately reduced if the total value of verified claims exceeds \$2,600,000.

Pursuant to that distribution formula, all members of the PRE-ARRAIGNMENT STRIP SEARCH CLASS, as defined above, booked during the Class Period, upon return of a verified Claim Form, shall receive the following:

- a. Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each booking, up to two (2), on a non-VDW Misdemeanor charge unless, within seven (7) years prior to the qualifying booking, the SCM had been arrested on two or more occasions on VDW offenses, whether Felony or Misdemeanor Offenses, in Santa Cruz County or, at the time of such booking, was on parole or searchable probation;
- b. Twelve Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,250.00) for each booking, up to two (2), on a non-VDW Felony charge unless, within seven (7) years prior to the qualifying booking, the SCM had been arrested on two or more occasions on VDW offenses, whether Felony or Misdemeanor offenses, in Santa Cruz County or, at the time of such booking, was on parole or searchable probation;
- c. Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350.00) if the SCM was booked on a non-VDW Felony or Misdemeanor offense and was on probation, the conditions of which included a requirement to submit to a search, and who was not arrested in Santa Cruz County on two or more occasions on VDW offenses, whether Felony or Misdemeanor offenses, within the seven (7) years proceeding the qualifying booking.

All POST RELEASE STRIP SEARCH CLASS members booked during the Class Period on any offense who, within eight (8) days of booking were ordered released by the Court and strip searched following return to jail, shall receive Twelve Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,250.00), if the offense on which the person was booked was a misdemeanor; or Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) if the offense on which the person was booked was a Felony. Regardless of the number of times a person was strip searched following being ordered released within eight (8) days of booking, persons in the POST RELEASE STRIP SEARCH CLASS will receive only one payment for any and all post release strip searches. Persons in the POST RELEASE STRIP SEARCH CLASS may also receive payments if they qualify for membership in the PRE-ARRAIGNMENT STRIP SEARCH CLASS.

In addition to the sums specified above, all SCMs in the PRE-ARRAIGNMENT STRIP SEARCH CLASS will become eligible to receive additional sums, referred to as "Enhancements" of Five Hundred Dollars for each applicable condition if they were under 21 or over 60 at the time of the qualifying Strip Search, had a physical or mental disability at the time of Strip Search, or were pregnant at the time of Strip Search. SCMs in the PRE-ARRAIGNMENT STRIP SEARCH CLASS will receive enhancements of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) each if, at the time of the Strip Search, the SCM was menstruating.

In addition, the SCMs in the PRE-ARRAIGNMENT STRIP SEARCH CLASS may become eligible to receive amounts, to be determined by negotiations between Class Counsel and the County's counsel, of not less than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or

more than Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) if, at the time they submit a timely claim form to the administrator, they also submit medical or psychological records or reports from licensed physicians or psychologists, marriage and family counselors, or clinical social workers establishing that, within 90 days after the Strip Search which is the subject of their claim, they received treatment for a physical, emotional or psychological injury caused by the Strip Search. All documentation of such claimed injuries will be provided to counsel for the County, who will be afforded a reasonable period of time to investigate each such claim, including taking depositions and obtaining additional records. In the event that Class Counsel and the County's Counsel cannot agree on an amount to resolve the claim of any SCM described in this paragraph, all documentation pertaining to that SCM's claim will be submitted to the Special Master, along with each counsel's proposed amount for an award, and the Special Master will determine the amount of the award, based upon the documents submitted to him.

3. Reduction of Awards.

Awards to claimants will be reduced by 50% if, at any time during the five years preceding the qualified booking, the claimant was sentenced and confined in any California County jail or in a California State Penitentiary or Correctional Institution. Net awards to claimants may be further reduced by up to a maximum of 50% of any remaining funds due for certain unpaid debts to the County of Santa Cruz for unpaid work furlough fees, unpaid child support, restitution ordered or payments due to the Victims of Violent Crime Fund, or for other debts collectible by the County of Santa Cruz or its agents.

C. Your Options as a Class Member.

1. Be Bound by, and Participate in the Settlement.

To qualify for a payment, you must send in a completed Claim Form to the Claims Administrator. A Claim Form is included in this notice package. Remember, if you do not send a Claim Form, you cannot get a payment. Also, please note that Class Members who have already settled their claims with the County of Santa Cruz or gone to trial with the County of Santa Cruz cannot receive a payment under this settlement. If you submit a Claim Form, you will be bound by the Settlement and receive money (if you are a class member). If you do not submit a Claim form but did not exclude yourself from the class, you will be bound by the terms of the Settlement and dismissal entered in this case, but you will not receive any money.

By participating in the Settlement you will be waiving all your rights to all claims up to July 14, 2007, related to strip searches that took place in any Santa Cruz County correctional facility, even those of which you are not aware at present. This waiver will include a waiver of the provisions of California Civil Code §1542, which provides that "a general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him must have materially affected his settlement with the debtor." By participating, you will be giving up unsuspected claims in the areas covered by the litigation.

2. Exclude Yourself From the Class.

You do not have to take part in the Settlement or be a member of the class. This is called "excluding" yourself. If you exclude yourself, you cannot get a payment and you cannot object to the Settlement. Any Court orders will not apply to you. To exclude yourself, you must sign a request for exclusion letter that states that you want to be excluded from Butler, et al. v. County of Santa Cruz, et al., Case No. C 07-00941 JF. Your exclusion letter must be mailed and postmarked before December 18, 2008, to: **Butler v. County of Santa Cruz Strip Search Class Action, c/o Claims Administrator, P.O. Box 8060, San Rafael, CA 94912-8060.**

If you do not follow these instructions properly, you will lose your right to exclude yourself. If you exclude yourself, you cannot get any money from the Settlement and you cannot tell the Court you do not like the Settlement (which is called "objecting"). If you

exclude yourself, you are no longer part of the class or the Settlement, but you can sue the County of Santa Cruz on your own if you choose to do so.

D. Fairness Hearing and Process for Objections.

A fairness hearing will be held on **January 16, 2009, at 9:00 a.m.**, at the United States District Court, Northern District of California, San Jose Division, 280 South 1st Street, Courtroom 3, San Jose, CA 95113. If you are a class member and do not exclude yourself, you can tell the Court you do not like the Settlement or some part of it at this hearing. This is called objecting to the Settlement. For example, you can say you do not think the Settlement is fair or adequate. The Court will consider your views.

To object, you must send a letter to the Court that contains all of the following: (1) The name and title of the lawsuit, Butler, et al. v. County of Santa Cruz, et al., Case No. C 07-00941 JF; (2) A statement of each objection you have and the facts that support the objections; (3) A description of any law or case supporting the objections; (4) A statement on whether or not you or your lawyer will ask to appear at the Fairness Hearing to talk about your objections, and, if so, how long you will need to present your objections; and (5) Copies of any documents you or your lawyer will present at the Fairness Hearing.

Individually, or through counsel, any class member has the right to object to the proposed Settlement as a whole, to the amount of attorneys' fees and costs of Class Counsel, or to any portion of either. ANY SUCH OBJECTIONS MUST BE FILED IN WRITING ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 18, 2008, IN THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT, NORTHERN DISTRICT OF CALIFORNIA, SAN JOSE DIVISION, LOCATED AT 280 South 1st Street, Courtroom 3, San Jose, CA 95113, ATTN: CLERK, RE: BUTLER V. COUNTY OF SANTA CRUZ SETTLEMENT, CASE NO. C 07-00941 JF. If you wish to appear and present your objections at the fairness hearing, you must also submit a Notice of Intention to Appear that identifies the case, contains your name and address, and explains the reason the appearance is desired. The Notice of Intention to Appear and any objections must be filed with the Court on or before December 18, 2008. You may be represented by your own attorney. If you are to be represented by an attorney at the hearing, his or her name, address and telephone number must be included in the Notice of Intention to Appear as well.
