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2. That plaintiff Emma Bradford recover of defendant NCS Pearson, Inc., the sum of \$24,189.00, with interest thereon at the rate of five per cent as provided by law from the date of entry of this Judgment;

3. That plaintiff Mary Coco recover of defendant NCS Pearson, Inc., the sum of \$24,462.28, with interest thereon at the rate of five per cent as provided by law from the date of entry of this Judgment;

4. That plaintiff William Damron recover of defendant NCS Pearson, Inc., the sum of \$36,347.00, with interest thereon at the rate of five per cent as provided by law from the date of entry of this Judgment;

5. That plaintiff Gail Dixon recover of defendant NCS Pearson, Inc., the sum of \$36,347.00, with interest thereon at the rate of five per cent as provided by law from the date of entry of this Judgment;

6. That plaintiff Russell Dooley recover of defendant NCS Pearson, Inc., the sum of \$21,336.84, with interest thereon at the rate of five per cent as provided by law from the date of entry of this Judgment;

7. That plaintiff Karen Dutter recover of defendant NCS Pearson, Inc., the sum of \$24,158.00, with interest thereon at the rate of five per cent as provided by law from the date of entry of this Judgment;

8. That plaintiff Sandra Espinoza recover of defendant NCS Pearson, Inc., the sum of \$22,347.00, with interest thereon at the rate of five per cent as provided by law from the date of entry of this Judgment;

9. That plaintiff Leroy Fich recover of defendant NCS Pearson, Inc., the sum of \$20,566.58, with interest thereon at the rate of five per cent as provided by law from the date of entry of this Judgment;

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10. That plaintiff Melinda Gammage recover of defendant NCS Pearson, Inc., the sum of \$20,254.80, with interest thereon at the rate of five per cent as provided by law from the date of entry of this Judgment;

21. That plaintiff Robert Tappert recover of defendant NCS Pearson, Inc., the sum of \$25,534.00, with interest thereon at the rate of five per cent as provided by law from the date of entry of this Judgment;

22. That plaintiff Diana Wadley recover of defendant NCS Pearson, Inc., the sum of \$36,347.00, with interest thereon at the rate of five per cent as provided by law from the date of entry of this Judgment; and

23. That plaintiff Judith Detmer take nothing, and that the action be dismissed as to Judith Detmer, on the merits.

II

This matter also came before the Court on the Motions for Summary Judgment of defendant NCS Pearson, Inc. Stoltz, Ivana Tarabochia, Dianna Thorkildson, and Natalia Zhikareva.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that those plaintiffs shall take nothing, and the action is dismissed as to them on the merits.

III

On December 8, 2004, the Court entered an Order of Involuntary Dismissal as to plaintiffs Amie Baledge, Nathan DeCeaser, Myrna Hipp, Troy Jones, Barbara Kloulechad, Janette Moldenhauer, and Remy Scott, and on January 25, 2006, the Court entered an Order of Dismissal as to plaintiff Mary Ann Hernandez.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that those plaintiffs shall take nothing, and the action is dismissed as to them with prejudice.

IV

No party is awarded costs or attorney fees.
