ORDER

On June 17, 2010, the Court issued an order in which it directed the Defendant, the City of Detroit ("City"), to remit a \$1,000 fine to the Clerk of the Court each business day commencing on June 18, 2010 until such time as the City submitted to the Court final versions of the following items:

- (a) standard operating procedures for the Office of the Chief Investigator,
- (b) a case management system, and
- (c) a plan to clear the backlog of citizen complaints and address and resolve any new cases.

As reflected on the official docket entries in this cause, the City has remitted \$1,000 to the Clerk of the Court each business day from June 18, 2010 through June 29, 2010. On June 30, 2010, the City filed a set of documents which it contends were developed with the input and approval of the Independent Monitor and the Plaintiff, the Department of Justice. The City further asserts that these submissions comport with the above-referenced requirements.

Based on its review of the record, the Court concludes that a cessation of the fines imposed against the City is warranted. Therefore, effective June 30, 2010, the Court suspends the sanctions

imposed against the City, with recognition that each of the foregoing items must ultimately be approved by the Court.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
