O R D E R

AND NOW, this 22 day of May, 1978, it  
is hereby ORDERED that the proposed Consent Decree filed  
April 8, 1976, is APPROVED with the following modifications:

1. The amendments to the proposed Consent Decree  
contained in the stipulation of the parties entered into on  
May 15, 1978; and
2. Section VIIC(1) is stricken and replaced with  
the following provision:

"All publications except newspapers  
and magazines may be received from  
any source, with the following proviso:  
Covers of hard-bound publications  
received from sources other than  
the original source (e.g., publisher,  
bookstore, distributor or department  
store) may be damaged or removed  
where inspection of the cover is  
deemed necessary and no reasonably  
available alternative form of in-  
spection is adequate.

Magazines and newspapers must be  
mailed directly from the original source  
(e.g., publisher, bookstore, distributor  
or department store) with the following  
proviso:

"Small letter-sized pamphlets may  
be received in regular correspond-  
ence from family members, friends  
or religious advisors."
