ORDER

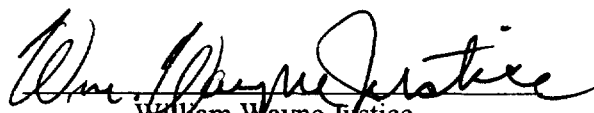
Pineywoods Home Team Affordable Housing, Inc. has filed a motion for reconsideration of this court's order denying leave to intervene as plaintiff in the above-styled and numbered civil action. Pineywoods, a non-profit "community housing development corporation" in East Texas, seeks to file a amended complaint for equitable relief against the Department of Housing and Urban Development, for allegedly failing to provide financial subsidies and guarantees related to the proposed construction of two apartment complexes.

The motion for reconsideration is without merit. It is found that the movant's interest will not be significantly impaired absent intervention, and that the existing plaintiffs in this civil action can adequately represent the movant's interest. Fed. R. Civ. P. 24(a). Moreover, it is found that the intervention will unduly delay the adjudication of the rights of the original parties. Fed. R. Civ. P. 24(b). Accordingly, the motion for reconsideration [docket no. 723] shall be, and is hereby,

DENIED. Furthermore, Pineywoods's motion for enlargement of time to reply to defendants' response to the motion to intervene [docket no. 720] shall be, and is hereby,

DISMISSED, as being moot.
