CLEAR WINDOWS THAT WILL ALLOW THE PASSAGE OF SUNLIGHT
AND ALLOW THE INMATES TO SEE OUT.
5. THAT ALL INMATES BE SUPPLIED WITH ADEQUATE, SANITARY
FOOTWEAR UPON ENTRY OF THE JAIL.
