**ORDER REGARDING PERIODIC

AND COSTS**

This matter having come before the Court on the parties' Stipulation Regarding Periodic
Payment of Attorneys' Fees and Costs, docket no. 148, and having been duly considered, it is
hereby

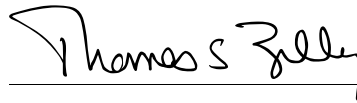
1. Pursuant to 42 U.S.C. §§ 1988 and 12205, the parties' Stipulation Regarding Periodic Payment of Attorneys' Fees and Costs, docket no. 148, is APPROVED.
2. Pursuant to the parties' agreement, Defendants shall pay \$716,090.66 to Plaintiffs' counsel. Defendants have 15 days from the entry of this Order to make the payment.
3. On an annual basis, Plaintiffs' counsel shall submit a billing statement to Defendants' counsel for attorneys' fees and costs no later than August 1. The billing period reflected in that statement will be from July 1 of the previous calendar year to June 30 of the same year in which the statement is submitted. The billing statement will itemize the biller, the biller's hourly rate, the task performed and the dates of performance, the time spent, plus any costs and expenses incurred.
4. The parties will engage in a meet and confer period during which time they will attempt in good faith to resolve any disputes and to negotiate an agreed amount of attorneys' fees and costs to be paid to Plaintiffs' counsel. The meet and confer period will expire 60 days from the date of Defendants' receipt of the billing statement, but may be extended at the parties' mutual written agreement. Once the meet and confer period expires, if there has been no resolution on the amount of attorneys' fees and costs to be paid or on any component thereof (for example, on billing rates), the parties will submit the matter for mediation to a mutually agreeable mediator.
5. If attempts to mediate are not successful within 30 days, Plaintiffs may file an appropriate motion with the Court.

6. If the parties reach agreement as to the payment of attorneys' fees and costs, the parties shall present a stipulated order for payment of the fees and costs.

Defendants will have 15 days from the entry of any such stipulated order to pay the fees and costs.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
