this defendant Local 38.

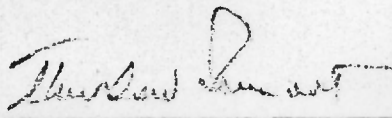
3. Same as #2.

use a card showing the request for referral from an employer,

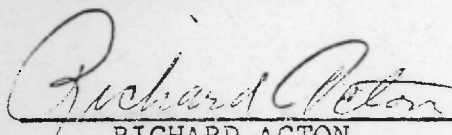
the job to be filled, the shop, the company, the date of the request, and copy of this card is sent as confirmation to the employer.

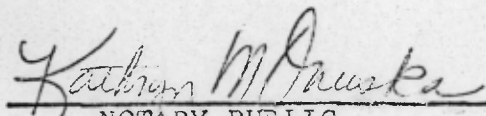
