ORDER

On application of Anderson L. Dobbins and the United States, plaintiffs in the above consolidated cases, after having been fully advised in open court by counsel for plaintiffs and counsel for defendant IBEW Local No. 212; and since the defendant has announced its intention of holding a journeyman examination on June 29, 1968; and since the journeyman testing program of the defendant union is challenged as an inappropriate means for measuring the knowledge or skills required for work performed in the electrical construction industry; and since the defendant's procedures for selecting persons to participate in this testing program also are being challenged,

this court, pursuant to its jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. 1651 to preserve the status quo on matters which will be presented during trial on the above consolidated cases scheduled for July 9, 1968, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that:

The defendant IBEW Local No. 212 and any agents, successors or employees thereof, are enjoined from administering any journeyman examination for the purpose of admission of members for IBEW Local No. 212 or from taking any steps leading to the administration of such an examination until such time as these consolidated cases are tried on the merits and a decision on the merits has been entered on such cases.

The defendant IBEW Local No. 212 is not enjoined from accepting applications for journeyman membership from any person prior to the decision on the merits in these consolidated cases.

If a decision in this case has not been entered by September 1, 1968 this court will entertain any requests by the defendant IBEW Local No. 212 for a review of this order.
