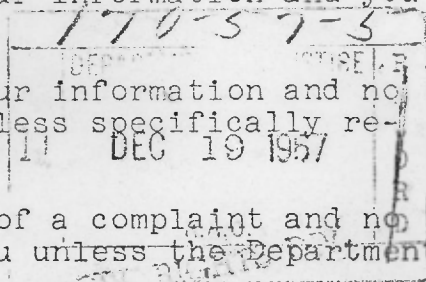

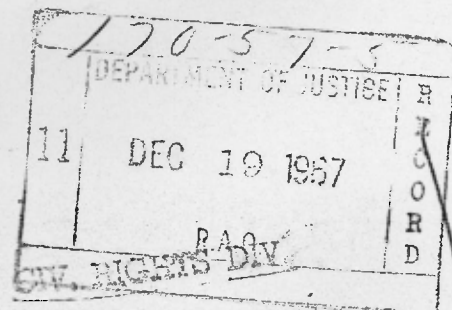

Miss Arlene B. Steuer, 345 Leader Building, Cleveland, Ohio, telephone number 781-0005, advised that she would be more than happy to furnish all information requested by the United States Government of Electrical Workers Local 1377, of which she is the attorney. She advised, however, that due to the Fair Employment Practices and the Civil Rights Act of 1964, all the unions which she represents do not on their membership, or anywhere else in their records, reveal the race of the membership. She advised she was concerned that if she were to make inquiry into the race of an individual there may occur many problems over such an inquiry. She stated she would like to be advised whether such statistics on the racial composition of the union, which numbers 5400, should be made on an inquiry basis or on an estimated basis. She stated the same problem exists with regard to referrals made by this local to Electrical Workers Local 38.
