Defendants objected to the request on several grounds. First, Defendants argue that Plaintiffs should have moved pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 35 because Rule 34 cannot be used to request a document that cannot exist. Second, Defendants have already conducted the test and the results twice indicated that Jamerson does not have HCV. Plaintiffs have not suggested that there is any basis to doubt the authenticity or veracity of the test results. Third, the request would lead the parties down a slippery slope. If Plaintiffs ask for additional testing for all of the class members, it would create enormous inefficiencies. Plaintiffs explained that Jamerson was first tested in 2015 and was told at the that time that he had chronic Hepatitis C. Viral load testing was first conducted in 2017, and that testing indicated that he did not have Hepatitis C. Plaintiffs are not asking at this time that the test be conducted for all class members; they are asking only that one of the three named plaintiffs be tested because of the unique circumstances. Plaintiffs argued that Defendants should not be allowed to dictate how Plaintiffs conduct discovery. Plaintiffs argued also that Defendants would not have been content to rely on an opposing experts findings without independently confirming them. Plaintiffs argued that they need not rely on Rule 35 to procure the blood sample because Rule 34 applies to tangible things. Plaintiffs noted that Defendants have not articulated any burden that would arise from providing the requested blood sample. Plaintiffs have arranged for the testing and payment. Finally, Plaintiffs noted that the information Plaintiffs seek is relevant to Jamersons status as a class representative and his damages issues that may be addressed in upcoming mediation. When asked by the Court whether they would prefer to proceed pursuant to Rule 35, with DOC transporting Jamerson to the laboratory of Plaintiffs choosing for testing, waiting while his blood sample is taken, and then transporting him back to the prison, or pursuant to Rule 34, with Corizon drawing a sample of Jamersons blood for transportation to a lab of Plaintiffs choosing, counsel for both Corizon and DOC agreed that, if the Court were to order one of the two measures, the latter would be preferable. The Court ordered Corizon to produce a blood sample from Mr. Jamerson on or before October 11, 2019. Plaintiffs are to arrange for the sample to be collected by the laboratory of their choice. If the parties are unable to reach agreement within 48 hours as to when the sample shall be collected, they are to contact the court on October 7, 2019 to arrange a teleconference. The Court noted that its ruling

		today is limited to the specific issue of Mr. Jamersons blood sample for HCV testing. Todays ruling does not reflect the Courts position as to whether similar discovery would be available for any other class member, or whether any such discovery would be available under Rule 34 or Rule 35.
