ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

The United States, having applied to this Court for an order to Show Cause, and it appearing from the record in this case and from the affidavits filed in support of the United States' application for this order that good cause exists therefor,

It is hereby ORDERED that each of the defendants appear before this Court on _____, at _____ o'clock _____ M. in the courtroom at the United States Courthouse and Post Office Building in _____, Alabama, to show cause, if any they have, why they, the defendants, their employees, successors and all persons in active concert or participation with them should not be enjoined, pending final disposition of this action, from:

1. Failing or refusing to enroll in _____

previously all-white schools all Negro students in desegregated grades who expressed their choice to attend such schools, and who still desire to attend such schools, in accordance with the provisions of the plan of desegregation of the ~~Missy~~ County Board of Education.

2. Denying to any Negro student the right to transfer to any grade in any school in the system from which he has been excluded because of his race.

3. Failing to provide bus service to the maximum extent feasible so as to serve each student who requires transportation, without regard to race.

It is further ORDERED that the United States Marshal shall serve forthwith a copy of this Order, together with the moving papers and accompanying affidavits, on counsel for the defendants and that the Clerk of this Court shall mail copies to all other counsel of record and shall notify all such counsel of the scheduled hearing.
