I am not very familiar with law or Court procedures and I am not
certain if I am in error or amiss in my motion contained herein
concerning a new cause arising from the Honorable Judge George R. Harris
dated 27, 1965 upon my petition for writ of Habeas Corpus #44309
and Petitioner.

I am poor and cannot afford to hire a lawyer and have no means to secure
services of one.

The Court gave November 8, 1965 as the date for the respondent to file a
motion and November 16, 1965 as the date deadline for myself to file a
motion (prior to)

would like to be appointed a counsel to see and represent me in this
case otherwise I am completely unable to compete with the lawyers for
myself and am unable to litigate my action.

I do not know the Court procedures in these matters and I am not sure
if this motion is proper or if there is a deadline, etc. But not having any
other way I drew up my request and hereby submit it.

I would like to know if it is possible for this to be appended to my original
motion and a counsel appointed or if that is not possible for it to be presented
to Judge Harris as soon as possible as a motion in direct connection to the
original motion and essentially a part of same.

Normally if the normal 21-30 day period, usually applied to original
motions I have sent in, is required, the purpose of the motion would be
lost as I have only 18 days to either win my petition or lose it (11-16-65).
If this motion can be presented to Judge Harris as the interested or presiding
in this action I would be most grateful and appreciative.
